Event

The International Association of Marine Aids to Navigation and Lighthouse Authorities (IALA) will host an IALA workshop on **the Global Sharing of Maritime Data** from **12 to 16 September 2011**, at the new IALA HQ, 10-14 rue des Gaudines, St Germain en Laye, 78100, France.

The workshop will examine all aspects of exchanging globally terrestrial and satellite AIS and other maritime data between maritime authorities: user needs, legal, policy and security aspects as well as technical aspects. IALA-NET will be taken as an example of a global data sharing network.

Participants will benefit from a better knowledge and the utility of global exchange of maritime data.

Background

This workshop is the continuation of the work of IALA in creating the IALA-NET, first as a demonstrator project launched at the 2008 VTS Symposium in Bergen Norway, and later as a permanent system from 1st July 2010. Based on the experience gained so far, the workshop will focus on the further development of concepts related to sharing maritime data to ensure safety of navigation, security, protection of the maritime environment and efficiency of maritime traffic.

It is set in the context of IALA Recommendation E-142 on Maritime Data Sharing "IALA-NET".

Objective

The workshop aims to provide an opportunity for delegates to discuss the utility of exchanging globally terrestrial and satellite AIS and other maritime data between maritime authorities;

Specifically, the workshop will address:

- User need, possible applications of data presently shared and potential added value of data to be shared in the future;
- Legal, policy and security aspects of sharing data in a global environment, in particular data ownership, timing and accessibility;
- Contemporary technical solutions and developments in network technology, storage and portrayal applications.

It is expected, that the workshop will conclude with the development of draft IALA Guidelines on Maritime Data Sharing.

Attendance

The workshop is directed towards authorities and others involved in exchanging maritime data to ensure safety of navigation, security, protection of the maritime environment and efficiency of maritime traffic. This includes Maritime Authorities in charge of AIS, VTS, Ports, Port State Control, SAR, Security, Navy, Environmental Protection and others concerned.

The working language of the workshop will be English.

The workshop fee is **€ 650** (Six hundred and fifty Euros)

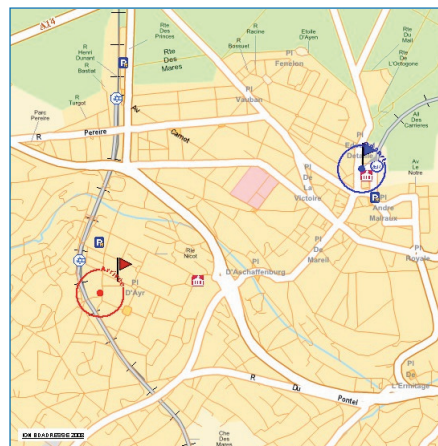
